

REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

February, 7th 2022

5:30 P.M.

The Haleyville City Council met in Regular Session in the Courtroom at the Haleyville City Hall at 5:30 P.M. on February 7, 2022. Jeff Mobley provided the invocation.

Mayor Ken Sunseri called the meeting to order and stated the following members were present: Mayor Ken Sunseri, Councilmember Ray Boshell Councilmember Julie “Boo” Brooks, Councilmember Brian Berry, and Councilmember Blue Russell via telephone. Absent – Councilmember Drew Thrasher. Acting City Clerk Christy Harbin , City Attorney Jeff Mobley, and City Engineer Calvin Cassidy were present.

The Mayor and City Council presented a proclamation declaring the month of February 2022 will be Kindness Month and commending Haleyville City Schools as well as Kimber Boshell, Mrs. Riddle, and Dr. Sutherland for their participation in The Greatest Kindness Challenge.

Councilmember Julie “Boo” Brooks made a motion for approval of the Regular Council Meeting minutes of January 18,2022 and his motion was seconded by Councilmember Ray Boshell. 


