

REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

March 7, 2022

5:30 P.M.

The Haleyville City Council met in Regular Session in the Courtroom at the Haleyville City Hall at 12:00 P.M. on March 7, 2022. Jeff Mobley provided the invocation.

Mayor Ken Sunseri called the meeting to order and stated the following members were present: Mayor Ken Sunseri, Councilmember Ray Boshell Councilmember Julie "Boo" Brooks, , and Councilmember Drew Thrasher. Absent –. Councilmember Brian Berry and Councilmember Blue Russell. Acting City Clerk Christy Harbin and City Attorney Jeff Mobley were present.

Councilmember Drew Thrasher made a motion for approval of the Regular Council Meeting minutes of February 22, 2022 and his motion was seconded by Councilmember Julie "Boo" Brooks. Mayor Sunseri asked all members of the council in favor to indicate by saying yea and all members voting were: Mayor Ken Sunseri, Councilmember Julie "Boo" Brooks, Councilmember Drew Thrasher, and Councilmember Ray Boshell. Abstain – None. Voting nay – None.

Councilmember Julie "Boo" Brooks made a motion for immediate consideration of to approve the resurfacing, fencing, nets, and straps for the tennis courts at a cost of \$45,339.60 to be paid from the Alcohol Fund and Councilmember Ray Boshell seconded the motion. Mayor Sunseri asked all members of the council in favor to indicate by saying yea and all members voting were: Mayor Ken Sunseri, Councilmember Julie "Boo" Brooks, Councilmember Drew Thrasher, and Councilmember Ray Boshell. 


Mayor Sunseri gave an update on the medical helicopter that could potentially move to the City's airport in late summer or early fall.
